To prohibit the use of shock gloves by Federal law enforcement
officers to enforce the immigration laws, and for
other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Shock Act of
5 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF SHOCK GLOVES.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
3 rity shall prohibit the use of shock gloves by any Federal
4 law enforcement officer enforcing the immigration laws.

5 (b) STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT.—The
6 requirement described under subsection (a) shall apply to
7 any law enforcement officer enforcing the immigration
8 laws pursuant to section 287(g) of the Immigration and
9 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1357(g)).

10 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

11 (1) IMMIGRATION LAWS.—The term “immigra-
12 tion laws” has the meaning given such term under
13 section 101(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
14 Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)).

15 (2) SHOCK GLOVE.—The term “shock glove”
16 means a glove that may deliver an electric shock
17 when applied directly to the body of an individual,
18 including the CTG–5 G.L.O.V.E (Generated Low
19 Output Voltage Emitter) conductive distraction and
20 de-escalation device.
