Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Replace Update Body Worn Cameras and Stun Gun Technologies and Support in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Springfield Township Police Department, located at 1510 Paper Mill Road, Wyndmoor, PA 19038.

The funding would be used to purchase 30 stun guns and 30 body worn cameras (1 per officer), 10 in-car video cameras, instructor training, and associated hardware refreshes and warranties.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Springfield Township Police are in need of updated equipment and technology to protect both their officers and any individuals they come in contact with.
