I am requesting funding for the Living Science Laboratory for Agriculture and Workforce Development Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Upper Moreland Township School District, located at 509 Davisville Road, Willow Grove, PA 19090.

The funding would be used to construct a cutting-edge facility to address community health, workforce development, and food production.
